

## **Experience Ecology 2023 Registration Form**

By completing this registration form, you are agreeing to the following general terms and conditions of this on-campus activity:

- 1. You or a teacher from your school should complete the registration form. Where you are not the Head of Department or Curriculum Leader, your registration will need to be endorsed by one.
- There is no cost associated with the delivery of this activity on campus to your students. Travel (and transport) to and from
  The University of Queensland, St Lucia campus is at your expense. Prior to your visit, a campus map, bus alighting spots, and
  meeting point will be provided to you. Buses are not allowed to park on campus, so buses will need to organise parking
  independently.
- 3. Workshop A: Skills in Field Ecology is delivered by current UQ ecology and zoology students who have been trained to deliver the activities. These are based on the three mandatory practicals in Unit 3 of the new senior biology syllabus and are conducted in the field. It is recommended that students each bring a clipboard and writing materials.
- 4. UQ Lakes is home to many animals, including arthropods, reptiles, and birds. Feeding the wildlife is prohibited.
- Workshop B: Analysis and Interpretation of Ecological Data will show your students how to best process and analyse data, with an emphasis on scientific writing to enhance their responses to unseen stimulus in assessment settings.
- 6. Each student will be required to bring along a laptop for Workshop B: Analysis and Interpretation of Ecological Data. The laptops should be brought along fully charged. Prior to your visit, a sample data set will be provided to you that you will need to circulate among your students. Laptops must have working versions of Microsoft Excel 2013 or higher. Google sheets, tablets, or other online versions of Microsoft Excel will not work.
- 7. Lunch is BYO feel free to bring along picnic mats and take a photo for keepsake. Your students may also purchase food and drink on-campus, but this is not encouraged as it will be a busy time on campus.
- 8. Covered shoes are a must, and it is highly recommended that all apply sun protection (sunscreen, sunglasses, hats etc.).
- 9. All resources (manuals, worksheets, sample data sets etc.) provided to you from us are the intellectual property of The University of Queensland. Please do not reproduce or circulate them freely.
